

Case 4: GBR With Collagen

A 32-year-old male patient presented with a sports injury resulting in fracture of the maxillary right central incisor. The affected tooth was extracted, and the area was allowed to heal for 3 months. A buccal defect was noticed during osteotomy and a flap was reflected for better visualization (1). Implant was placed (2) and a huge buccal dehiscence was noticed (3). GBR with NovaBone Granules mixed with blood and a slow resorbing collagen membrane was performed and sutured (4,5). During second stage (4 months after implant placement), clinical picture (6) demonstrates excellent bone volume and contour.
